Task sheet – insta stories out of timelines

Summary

Timelines with historic events can be a helpful source of information to develop your own stories. The following steps are based on the given timeline representing 30 (or more) years of European history.

The task was designed to work together on an online platform.

Steps

- 1. Make teams
- 2. Decide who uploads the Instagram story
- 3. Look at the given timeline and decide.

Either

- choose as many historic events as you want to build your own timeline or
- choose one historic event and its connections in your team

4. Illustrate your chosen events

- Take photos of objects in your home / office (symbolic objects, objects from other European countries, souvenirs, boarding cards, maps, passports, money, books, etc.)
- Find photos in your own photo collections
- Create your own images: paint, draw, write, collage, use images from the internet (copyright!), experiment with whatever you have and can create, ...
- 5. Write your story (in an online document)
- 6. **Write down sources** (if you use any), include first names of the authors and photographers
- 7. Find hashtags which connect to your story
- 8. **Upload your story** either directly on the shiftingwalls_eu account or any other account using the #shiftingwalls_eu
